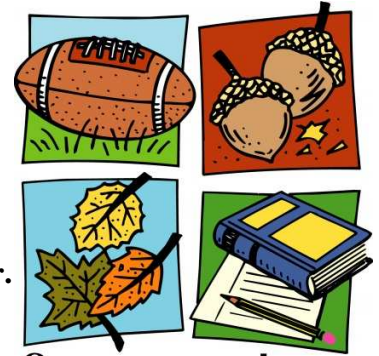


Prayer List for Sunday, September 21, 2014
